Whereas, earning the top spot two years in a row, Chris McMullin now has a near-perfect 39-1 win-loss record; and

Whereas, Chris McMullin was astutely guided in his training and competitions by coach Mike Fletchall; and

Whereas, it is fitting and proper that the Missouri House of Representatives should pause in its diverse legislative actions in order to acknowledge milestone events in the lives of such outstanding Missouri student athletes as Chris McMullin:

Now, therefore, be it resolved that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-fourth General Assembly, join unanimously to applaud the season-long accomplishments garnered by wrestler Chris McMullin and to convey to him this legislative body's most heartfelt congratulations upon taking First Place in the Class 3 state championships in the 285-pound weight division; and
