Whereas, Maxine Replogle loves to cook, an activity that led to her success as a cook at the Marshfield Child Development Center and in the Marshfield school system and as the owner of Mom's Café; and

Whereas, no stranger to honors and accolades, Maxine Replogle and her husband were given the Lifetime Achievement in Community Service award in 1992 by the Marshfield Area Chamber of Commerce; and

Whereas, while her husband was still alive, Maxine Replogle planted several acres of garden each year and sold or gave away vegetables to many of their friends and neighbors; and

Whereas, it is fitting and proper that the Missouri House of Representatives should pause in its diverse legislative actions in order to express sincere birthday wishes to such outstanding Missouri citizens as Maxine Replogle:
