Whereas, Darryl Lamson previously worked as a bridge inspector and civil works office engineer for the Maine State Highway Commission; as an architectural project engineer for Utley-James, Incorporated, in Pontiac, Michigan; and as a construction specialist for the Stone & Webster Engineering Corporation in Cherry Hill, New Jersey; and

Whereas, Darryl Lamson is justifiably proud also to be known as the beloved husband of Sharon Lamson:
