

## House Resolution No. 1181

**Whereas**, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives always welcome the opportunity to acknowledge milestone events in the lives of Show-Me State youths who admirably demonstrate their true potential as lifelong learners, involved citizens, and future societal leaders through their accomplishments in the Royal Rangers program; and

**Whereas**, Charlie Collins of Camdenton, Missouri, has attained considerable distinction as a member of Royal Rangers Outpost 64 who will receive his Gold Award of Achievement at a ceremony that will be performed on March 30, 2008, at First Assembly of God in Lebanon, Missouri; and

**Whereas**, the son of Charles and Waunita Collins, Charlie Collins served his fellow Royal Rangers for the past four years as a Discovery Rangers Patrol Guide and as an Adventure Rangers Patrol Guide and Senior Guide; and

**Whereas**, holder of thirteen red, six blue, fourteen gold, four green, and seven silver merit badges, Charlie Collins also garnered the Gold Falcon, Gold Hawk, and Gold Eagle in Discovery Rangers; the Powder Horn, Bowie Knife, Tomahawk, and Long Rifle to earn the Bronze Medal; Pine, Cedar, Oak, and Sequoia to earn the Silver Medal; and Second Class, First Class, Advanced, and Master to earn the Gold Medal; and

**Whereas**, Charlie Collins has attended the 2006 and 2007 Pow-Wows, a 2007 Merit Camp, and the 2006 and 2007 Pinewood Derby and has been recognized as a Sectional Ranger of the Year in 2007; and

**Whereas**, for his Service Project, Charlie Collins organized a group of Royal Rangers to paint handicap parking spots and to restripe the parking lot at First Assembly of God; and

**Whereas**, it is fitting and proper that the Missouri House of Representatives should pause in its diverse legislative actions in order to recognize such outstanding Missouri youths as Charlie Collins at momentous times in their lives:

**Now, therefore, be it resolved** that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-fourth General Assembly, join unanimously to applaud the personal accomplishments garnered thus far in the life of Charlie Collins and to convey to him this legislative body's most heartfelt congratulations upon earning a Gold Medal of Achievement from the Royal Rangers; and

**Be it further resolved** that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of Representatives be instructed to prepare a properly inscribed copy of this resolution for presentation to Charlie Collins of Camdenton, Missouri.
