Whereas, Patty Mohn is the author of "Saint Mary's Express" and has been active in the Blue Springs Community Fall Fun Fest, Beta Sigma Phi, PTA, First Methodist Church, and the Boy Scouts of America; and

Whereas, Patty Mohn brings to her work at the Liggett Trail Education Center a wealth of expertise garnered from earlier employment in the Raytown C-2 School District, as a private tutor, as a private preschool teacher and director, and as a kindergarten summer school and first-grade teacher in Blue Springs:
