

House Resolution No. 1328

Whereas, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives hold in high esteem those Show-Me State residents who have proven down through the years to be exemplary citizens in local communities and neighborhoods; and

Whereas, Glen and Martha Harmon have attained considerable distinction as the recipients of a gold-level President's Volunteer Service Award from the Missouri Community Service Commission; and

Whereas, Glen and Martha Harmon will be presented with their President's Volunteer Service Award on April 17, 2008, at the Missouri Community Service Commission annual Banquet on Volunteerism; and

Whereas, the Harmons have earned the President's Volunteer Service Award in light of their participation in several areas of Red Cross operations since September 2005; and

Whereas, Glen and Martha Harmon worked in numerous disasters of various types, volunteered 336 hours of their time during training and strategic planning sessions, became certified instructors and conducted training classes for 384 hours on behalf of the Red Cross, and traveled to Florida to retrieve the Red Cross Emergency Response Feeding Vehicle; and

Whereas, altogether Glen and Martha Harmon dedicated 6,772 hours since September 2005 to Red Cross activities, including 5,812 hours in a deployed status; and

Whereas, it is fitting and proper that the Missouri House of Representatives should pause in its diverse legislative actions in order to recognize such outstanding Missouri volunteers as Glen and Martha Harmon at momentous times in their lives:

Now, therefore, be it resolved that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-fourth General Assembly, join unanimously to applaud the well-deserved selection of Glen and Martha Harmon for a gold-level President's Volunteer Service Award from the Missouri Community Service Commission and to convey to them this legislative body's most heartfelt best wishes for continued success in life for many more years to come; and
