

House Resolution No. 1686

Whereas, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives feel it is altogether fitting and proper to pause from time to time to recognize individuals and organizations that have contributed to the welfare of this great state and its citizens or distinguished themselves through significant personal achievement; and

Whereas, the members now pause to recognize Mickey Carroll, of St. Louis, Missouri, who has been honored by being named an Honorary Board Member of the 1904 World's Fair Charitable Foundation Board, an office that will be officially bestowed upon him on April 9, 2008, in the State Capitol; and

Whereas, Mickey Carroll is known as an actor, and he will be forever remembered as one of the Munchkins in the legendary and timeless film "The Wizard of Oz" starring Judy Garland, released in 1939; and

Whereas, in addition to being an entertainer, Mickey Carroll is a philanthropist and volunteer fund-raiser in the St. Louis area, in Missouri, and in the United States; and

Whereas, Mickey Carroll has often been honored and recognized for his many accomplishments, and he was recently memorialized by a "Munchkin Star" on the Hollywood Walk of Fame; and

Whereas, the 1904 World's Fair Charitable Foundation includes prominent individuals from business, media, religious, and political communities who lend their good names and reputations to help the Foundation accomplish its goals; and

Whereas, the 1904 World's Fair Charitable Foundation is a not-for-profit 501(c)(3) organization founded on March 14, 2002, to celebrate the memory of the 1904 World's Fair and Olympics hosted by Saint Louis in Forest Park; and

Whereas, the 1904 World's Fair Charitable Foundation also raises capital for the Forest Park beautification program and to assist other local charities in a wide variety of fund-raising efforts:

Now, therefore, be it resolved that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-fourth General Assembly, applaud the selection of Mickey Carroll as an Honorary Member of the 1904 World's Fair Charitable Foundation Board; and

Be it further resolved that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of Representatives be instructed to prepare a properly inscribed copy of this resolution for Mickey Carroll.
