

## House Resolution No. 1810

**Whereas**, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives hold in high esteem those Show-Me State natives who admirably have answered the patriotic call to national service through their enlistment in any of the branches that make up the United States armed forces; and

**Whereas**, Rex Scott Biggs has attained considerable distinction as a Senior Master Sergeant in the Air National Guard, a leadership calling that he will draw to a close on August 1, 2008, in well-deserved retirement after twenty-five years of service; and

**Whereas**, currently stationed at Randolph Air Force Base in Texas, Senior Master Sergeant Rex Biggs previously served at Peterson AFB in Colorado; Floreenes AB in Belgium; Sheppard AFB in Texas; the 138 MSF in Tulsa, Oklahoma; and the 131 MSF in Saint Louis; and

**Whereas**, Senior Master Sergeant Rex Biggs is a Career Field Manager and Senior Personnel Systems Manager who trained at Keesler AFB in Mississippi, Sheppard AFB in Texas, the USAF Non-Commissioned Officer Academy in Saint Louis, Missouri, and the USAF Senior Non-Commissioned Officer Academy in Saint Louis; and

**Whereas**, Senior Master Sergeant Rex Biggs has earned the Meritorious Service Medal, Air Force Commendation Medal with oak leaf cluster, Air Force Achievement Medal with two oak leaf clusters, Air Force Outstanding Unit Award with three oak leaf clusters, Air Force Good Conduct Medal with two oak leaf clusters, Air Reserve Forces Meritorious Service Medal with two oak leaf clusters, National Defense Service Medal with bronze service star, Humanitarian Service Medal, Air forces Overseas Ribbon Short, Armed Forces Reserve Medal with bronze hourglass, United States Air force NCO Professional Military Education Graduate Ribbon with oak leaf cluster, Missouri Commendation Ribbon, and Eighth Air Force Total Force Excellence Award; and

**Whereas**, a Senior Master Sergeant since June 17, 2004, Rex Biggs is justifiably proud to be known as the son of Rex and Marilyn Biggs:
