

House Resolution No. 2188

Whereas, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives are fully cognizant of the important role which the Boy Scouts of America organization plays in offering a well-rounded program of activities designed to prepare young men for the many diverse challenges of responsible citizenship; and; and

Whereas, Joshua Delahanty, of St. Louis, Missouri, will receive the prestigious rank of Eagle Scout during a Court of Honor ceremony to be held on April 28, 2008, at Southview School, in Crestwood, Missouri; and

Whereas, Joshua Delahanty, a member of Boy Scout Troop 724, successfully met the requirements to attain Eagle status by completing his Eagle project and meeting all other criteria; and

Whereas, Joshua Delahanty's Eagle project consisted of developing a program, with the cooperation of the Metropolitan Sewer District, designed to educate St. Louis residents about the proper disposal of certain liquids into the sewer system and about what kinds of liquids should not be discharged into the system, and the program involved scouts passing out information door-to-door to about four hundred metropolitan homes; and

Whereas, in his fifteen years of scouting, Joshua Delahanty has earned thirty-two merit badges, is a Brotherhood member in the Order of the Arrow, and has demonstrated all the skills and attributes required to hold the offices of Senior Patrol Leader and Patrol Leader; and

Whereas, Joshua Delahanty has led his troop in the annual Scouting for Food effort for the last six years, led his troop for the last six years in the annual Memorial Day Good Turn, has been active in Special Color Guards for the District, and led the troop on outings to Shiloh Memorial Park in Tennessee; and

Whereas, Joshua Delahanty realizes that the Eagle rank will be recognized at all levels of our society as being a great achievement that requires considerable dedication and effort:

Now, therefore, be it resolved that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-fourth General Assembly, extend our congratulations to Joshua Delahanty and wish him every success in all his future endeavors; and

Be it further resolved that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of Representatives be instructed to prepare a properly inscribed copy of this resolution for presentation to Eagle Scout Joshua Delahanty, the son of Tim and Nancy Delahanty.
