Whereas, a Warrior member in the Tribe of Mic-O-Say, Christopher Walters has earned the Fifty-Mile Afoot/Afloat Award and Fifty-Miler Grand Teton Trek, Triple Crown High Adventure Award and served as Crew Leader at Philmont Scout Ranch, and he has attended Sea Base Sailing Adventure and OKPIK Winter Camping High Adventure Camp (Ely, Minnesota); and

Whereas, the goals of Scouting—citizenship training, character development, and personal fitness—remain important for all Scouts, whether or not they attain the Eagle Scout rank; and

Whereas, Christopher Walters realizes that the Eagle rank will be recognized at all levels of our society as being a great achievement that requires considerable dedication and effort:
