Whereas, Alisha Mehrhoff, a resident of Jefferson City, Missouri, has been chosen to attend the 21st Century Leadership Academy, a week-long residential program held on the campus of the University of Missouri-St. Louis from May 18 through May 23, 2008; and

Whereas, Alisha Mehrhoff is a junior at Lincoln University in Jefferson City, Missouri, with a double major in political science and history with a minor in business administration; and

Whereas, Alisha Mehrhoff is a member of Alpha Kappa Mu Honor Society, Pre-Law Club, and the Women's Leadership Academy; and

Whereas, in process of obtaining her pilot's license, Alisha Mehrhoff interned with Missouri Representative Bob Dixon in the spring of 2007 and with Missouri Representative John Quinn and Missouri Representative Joe Smith in 2008, and she was recently hired as a Legislative Assistant for Representative Smith; and

Whereas, Alisha Mehrhoff will be among students from Missouri universities in this prestigious and highly selective program, which is sponsored by the Sue Shear Institute for Women in Public Life; and

Whereas, the Leadership Academy has become a national model and includes activities such as a visit to the State Capitol in Jefferson City, where the Shear Fellows, as those selected are known, will engage in a mock legislative debate and meet with Supreme Court judges and state-wide elected officeholders, among other activities:
