Whereas, Angelica Whittington has traveled to Japan and studied language and culture extensively, and she studies both Japanese and Cantonese languages; and

Whereas, Angelica Whittington will be among students from Missouri universities in this prestigious and highly selective program, which is sponsored by the Sue Shear Institute for Women in Public Life; and

Whereas, the Leadership Academy has become a national model and includes activities such as a visit to the State Capitol in Jefferson City, where the Shear Fellows, as those selected are known, will engage in a mock legislative debate and meet with Supreme Court judges and state-wide elected officeholders, among other activities:
