Now, therefore, be it resolved that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-fourth General Assembly, join the Louisiana R-II School District in expressing appreciation for the unparalleled service that Cheryl Shaw rendered to Missouri's children and in wishing her the long, fruitful, and enjoyable retirement that she so justly deserves; and
