**Whereas**, Christopher Clegg's Eagle project consisted of cleaning and refurbishing over 500 Indian artifacts and installing them into display cases along with proper identification, with the assistance of local archeologists; and

**Whereas**, in his eight years in scouting, Christopher Clegg has earned an impressive thirty-three merit badges and demonstrated all the skills and attributes required for holding the office of Assistant Senior Patrol Leader (fourth term); and

**Whereas**, a proud member of the Order of the Arrow, Christopher Clegg is a well established scouting recruiter and the winner of the snorkeling award; and

**Whereas**, a participant in many camporees and camporals, Christopher Clegg attended a High Adventure trip in 2006 that took him to South Dakota, Wyoming, Colorado, and Montana, and while on his High Adventure, he spent time with a couple that were Lakota, Sioux, and Cherokee who taught him and his fellow scouts the Indian Lore Merit Badge, and they ate authentic native American food and participated in a sweat lodge ceremony, with Christopher Clegg being considered the "Medicine Man" of the tribe; and

**Whereas**, Christopher Clegg realizes that the Eagle rank will be recognized at all levels of our society as being a great achievement that requires considerable dedication and effort:

**Now, therefore, be it resolved** that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-fourth General Assembly, extend our congratulations to Christopher Clegg and wish him every success in all his future endeavors; and
