Whereas, the St. Louis Women of Achievement Award is the oldest, on-going program in the area whose sole mission is to honor and recognize the volunteer efforts of women, and it serves both as a “thank you” to its recipients and as an inspiration to others; and

Whereas, Susan Philpott is well known and universally respected for her volunteer work with a number of educational and related organizations, most notably Reading Is Fundamental, OASIS Intergenerational Tutoring Program, Planned Parenthood, “Speak English with Us”, Springboard To Learning/Young Audiences, St. Louis Public Schools Foundation, Gateway Foundation, Scholarship Foundation of St. Louis, John Burroughs School, Aim High St. Louis, and the Women’s Society of Washington University:
