Whereas, the son of Vernie A. and Mildred Beu Glazier, Robert Glazier has been abundantly blessed with the love and admiration of a wonderful family whose members include his devoted wife of fifty-nine years, Harriette; his two sons, Gregory Kent Glazier and Jeffrey Robert Glazier; and his grandson, Justin David Glazier:
