Whereas, Golden Echoes Center in Steelville, Missouri, will commemorate the resplendent occasion of its Thirtieth Anniversary with a special celebration to be held July 13, 2008; and

Whereas, a non-profit organization, Golden Echoes is best known for providing the Senior Citizen Meal Program to the citizenry of the Steelville community, serving its first meal in its current facility on July 5, 1978; and

Whereas, Golden Echoes was incorporated on September 19, 1975, following which the process of purchasing land for a building and securing an architect and general construction contractor was put in place by board members Marie McDole, Virginia Reisinger, Shirley Reed, B.L. "Doc" Halbert, Rosemary E. Kehr, Manford Rhea, Paul Perkins, Frances Guess, and Ferne Baker; and

Whereas, the original building was paid for in 1983, while plans for an addition were made and construction was completed on the addition in 1989:
