Now, therefore, be it resolved that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-fourth General Assembly, join in expressing deep gratitude for the superb service that Kent Van Landuyt has rendered to the Show-Me State during the past forty years and in wishing him ample opportunity to enjoy such things as model trains and other railroad memorabilia; and
