

## House Resolution No.

**Whereas**, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives hold in high esteem those Show-Me State residents who have proven down through the years to be exemplary citizens in local communities and neighborhoods; and

**Whereas**, Jack F. Moore of Nixa, Missouri, attained considerable distinction as a member of the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, from which he retired on April 1, 1997; and

**Whereas**, initiated into IBEW Local Union 453 on September 17, 1948, Jack Moore accepted increasingly responsible positions with the union at the local, state, and international levels of service; and

**Whereas**, Jack Moore was appointed International Secretary of the IBEW on October 1, 1985, after which time he was elected at the 1986 convention and re-elected at the 1991 and 1996 conventions; and

**Whereas**, Jack Moore prepared for his diverse career endeavors by graduating from Republic High School in 1943, attending Apprentice Wireman School from 1947 to 1950, and taking labor management courses at Drury University; and

**Whereas**, Jack Moore served in the United States Navy from April 1944 to June 1946 and again from August 1950 to February 1951; and

**Whereas**, an involved, community-minded citizen for his entire life, Jack Moore deserves mention of his service and leadership with the Springfield Public Utilities Advisory Board, Springfield Regional Airport Board, Springfield Park Board, Greene County Cancer Society, American Red Cross Board, and United Way Board; and

**Whereas**, Jack Moore also served on the Executive Committee of United Labor, Governor Teasdale's Advisory Council, a Comprehensive Health Planning group, the State Board of Mediation, the Build Missouri Committee Coordinating Council, Governor Teasdale's Commission on Campaign Reform, and President Kennedy's Missile Site Commission in Missouri, among others:

**Now, therefore, be it resolved** that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-fourth General Assembly, join unanimously to applaud the personal and professional accomplishments garnered thus far in the life of Jack Moore and to convey to him this legislative body's most heartfelt best wishes for continued success for many more years to come; and
