Whereas, a York Rite and Scottish Rite Mason, Dr. Robert Hatten also is a member of the American Chiropractic Association and the Missouri State Chiropractic Association, a Trustee for Cleveland Chiropractic College of Kansas City and Cleveland College of Los Angeles, a participant in the preceptorship program of Logan College of Chiropractic in Saint Louis, a member of the Chiropractic Knights of the Round Table, a Fellow of the International College of Chiropractic, and a member of the Ambassadors Society of Cleveland College of Chiropractic; and

Whereas, Dr. Robert Hatten meets with patients three days a week, which gives him sufficient time to spend in the avocational pursuit of fishing for crappie:
