

House Resolution No. 3646

Whereas, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives hold in high esteem those Show-Me State residents who have proven down through the years to be exemplary citizens in local communities and neighborhoods through their hard work, dedication, and civic-minded leadership; and

Whereas, Clifford "Click" Roschevitz of Rocky Comfort, Missouri, has attained universal praise in light of his thirty-eight years of unparalleled service to the city of Stella; and

Whereas, originally a member of the Stella Board of Trustees and a volunteer fire fighter, Click Roschevitz became employed by Stella city government as a water meter reader in 1970, after which time he proved instrumental in repairing water lines and in getting the sewer system installed; and

Whereas, Click Roschevitz also was a businessman who built a gas station specializing in fuel and lubricant sales and in car repair and which eventually was expanded into a convenience store; and

Whereas, even after Click Roschevitz bought a farm and moved out in the country to raise cattle, he remained active in the Stella community by accepting water and sewer system payments at his convenience store and by obtaining certification as a Water Technician and a Sewer Technician; and

Whereas, Click Roschevitz is justifiably proud to be known as the beloved husband of Freda Roschevitz, whom he married on June 21, 1963, at Stella Baptist Church; the loving father of Faron and Rhonda Roschevitz and of Markeeta and Roger Harvey; and wonderful grandfather of Kelby Roschevitz, Kolton Roschevitz, Coty Roschevitz, and Kaily Harvey; and

Whereas, it is fitting and proper that the Missouri House of Representatives should pause in its diverse daily activities in order to recognize such outstanding Missouri citizens as Click Roschevitz:

Now, therefore, be it resolved that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-fourth General Assembly, join unanimously to applaud the personal and professional accomplishments garnered thus far in the life and work of Click Roschevitz and to convey to him this legislative body's most heartfelt commendation of his many years of community service to the town of Stella, Missouri; and
