Whereas, a Warrior in the Tribe of Mic-O-Say and a Brotherhood member in the Order of the Arrow, Andrew William Ryan O'Neil has earned an impressive thirty-six merit badges in his nine years of scouting and demonstrated all the skills and attributes required for holding the offices of Den Chief, Troop Guide, and Senior Patrol Leader; and

Whereas, a sophomore at Oak Park High School, Andrew William Ryan O'Neil is the proud holder of the Ad Altare Dei religious award and Master Camper Award; and

Whereas, Andrew William Ryan O'Neil has attended Junior National Leadership Training at Brownsea, completed One Hundred Nights of camping, H. Roe Bartle Scout Reservation for five years, and the National Scout Jamboree at Fort A.P. Hill, Virginia, in 2005; and

Whereas, Andrew William Ryan O'Neil realizes that the Eagle rank will be recognized at all levels of our society as being a great achievement that requires considerable dedication and effort:

Now, therefore, be it resolved that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-fourth General Assembly, extend our congratulations to Andrew William Ryan O'Neil and wish him every success in all his future endeavors; and
