Whereas, a holder of the World Conservation Award, Mile Swim, and Snorkeling award and a Foxman in the Tribe of Mic-O-Say, Jackson Charles Leggett attended summer camp in Osceola, Missouri, for three straight years and attended Seabase High Adventure in the summer of this year; and

Whereas, Jackson Charles Leggett realizes that the Eagle rank will be recognized at all levels of our society as being a great achievement that requires considerable dedication and effort:
