Whereas, Roy Holler has served three different times as Commander of Post 240 of the American Legion, a total of six years as Commander, and he has held the office of First Vice Commander of the Post; and

Whereas, Roy Holler retired from the United States Army with the rank of Sergeant First Class; and

Whereas, Roy Holler has been blessed with the love and support of a wonderful family, whose members include his wife, Laura J. Holler, a son, Roy Holler, Jr., and Treasa, Beverly, Dallas, and Kelli, among many other devoted and affectionate family members:

Now, therefore, be it resolved that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-fourth General Assembly, join to extend our most sincere gratitude to Roy Holler for his years of devotion and service; and
