

House Resolution No. 4573

Whereas, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives hold in high esteem those Show-Me State residents who admirably help enhance the quality of life in local communities and neighborhoods through the excellence of their contributions to the field of public safety; and

Whereas, Fredrick Luckritz of Richland, Missouri, has attained considerable distinction as a dispatcher with the Pulaski County Sheriff's Department and as a member of the Tri-County Fire and Rescue service; and

Whereas, while working traffic control at an accident scene on Interstate 44 on December 15, 2007, Fredrick Luckritz saw a vehicle approaching dangerously fast and close to persons working at the scene; and

Whereas, despite the best efforts of Fredrick Luckritz, a firefighter working at the accident was struck and seriously injured by a 2000 Jeep Grand Cherokee; and

Whereas, the astute actions of Fredrick Luckritz undoubtedly diminished the impact of the vehicle against the firefighter and in all probability saved him from death; and

Whereas, it is fitting and proper that the Missouri House of Representatives should pause in its diverse daily activities in order to recognize the achievements and sacrifices made by members of local public safety organizations:

Now, therefore, be it resolved that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-fourth General Assembly, join unanimously to commend the high levels of professionalism in evidence in the work of Fredrick Luckritz and to convey to him this legislative body's most heartfelt congratulations for his role in saving the life of a firefighter; and

Be it further resolved that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of Representatives be instructed to prepare a properly inscribed copy of this resolution for presentation to Fredrick Luckritz of Richland, Missouri.
