Whereas, the 2008 Crusaders volleyball team ended the season with 25 wins, 7 losses, and 2 ties and was ranked in the Class 4 Top 10 all year under the astute guidance of head coach David Harris and assistant coaches Courtney Schenewerk, Melissa Price, and Bill Wolters; and

Whereas, a member of Saint Joseph's Parish, Amanda Henley is a two-year letter winner who is active in freshman mentoring, Club International, Art Club, National Honor Society, Sports Medicine, the Central Missouri Volleyball Club, and Relay for Life; was named to the 2008 All-District and 2008 All-Region teams in volleyball and the 2007 Academic All-State team; was on the 2007 Class 4 Sectional championship team; and was one of five senior players who coordinated a Dig Pink event, for which the team dedicated the October 6th match to breast cancer awareness; and

Whereas, it is fitting and proper that the Missouri House of Representatives should pause in its diverse daily activities in order to recognize such outstanding Missouri students as Amanda Henley:
