Whereas, Don Danforth, III is the past recipient of the Community Leadership Award from the St. Louis Bar Foundation; the Opportunity Maker Award from Boys Hope Girls Hope; the St. Louis Emerging Leaders Award from CORO Leadership Center-St. Louis; the Community Champion Award from Area Resources for Community & Human Resources; the MOKAN Outstanding Service Award; the Bill Maritz Award from Mathews-Dickey Boys' and Girls' Club; the Princeton Award from the Princeton Club of St. Louis; 40 under 40 from the "St. Louis Business Journal"; the I Dare You Leadership Award from the American Youth Foundation; and the Outstanding Volunteer Tutor Award from the Mathews-Dickey Boys' Club; and

Whereas, City Academy, a private, independent elementary school in North St. Louis offering children a rigorous college preparatory education at an affordable cost that relies on financial support from the St. Louis community, was established in 1999 to serve families seeking a challenging curriculum, low student-teacher-ratios, and high expectations of students and faculty; and

Whereas, City Academy grew out of Don Danforth, III's experience with Mathews-Dickey Boys' and Girls' Club, where he began volunteering in 1989, while working in marketing for Ralston Purina Company, and ultimately took charge of the Club's educational programs in 1993; and

Whereas, Don Danforth, III holds a bachelor of arts degree in English writing and history from St. Lawrence University, and he has been actively involved in the St. Louis community ever since graduating, serving on the Board of the American Youth Foundation, the Board of Mary Institute-St. Louis Country Day School, and Teach for America's St. Louis Advisory Board; and

Whereas, Don Danforth, III is the devoted husband of Susannah Webb Danforth and the loving father of Carolyn St. John Danforth, Donald Danforth, IV, Charles Ross Danforth, and Henley Upham Danforth:

Now, therefore, be it resolved that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-fourth General Assembly, join to extend our congratulations to Don Danforth, III, on the illustrious occasion of his being honored with Stellar Performance in Education Award; and
