AN ACT

To amend chapter 227, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the designation of a memorial highway.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 227, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 227.403, to read as follows:

2 **227.403. The portion of Highway 63 from the Iowa state line in Schuyler County**
3 **to the intersection of the Callaway County and Boone County line shall be designated the**
4 **"Pearl Harbor Memorial Highway". The department of transportation shall erect and**
5 **maintain appropriate signs designating such highway, with the cost to be paid for by**
6 **private donations.**

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.
