### AN ACT

To repeal section 9.010, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to public holidays, with an emergency clause.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Section 9.010, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof,  
2 to be known as section 9.010, to read as follows:

9.010. The first day of January, the third Monday of January, [the twelfth day of  
2 February,] the third Monday in February, [the eighth day of May,] the last Monday in May, the  
3 fourth day of July, the first Monday in September, the second Monday in October, the eleventh  
4 day of November, the fourth Thursday in November, and the twenty-fifth of December, are  
5 declared and established public holidays; and when any of such holidays falls upon Sunday, the  
6 Monday next following shall be considered the holiday. There shall be no holiday for state  
7 employees on the fourth Monday of October.

Section B. Because immediate action is necessary to retain a balanced Missouri state  
2 budget during economic hardship, section A of this act is deemed necessary for the immediate  
3 preservation of the public health, welfare, peace, and safety, and is hereby declared to be an  
4 emergency act within the meaning of the constitution, and section A of this act shall be in full  
5 force and effect upon its passage and approval.
