AN ACT

To amend chapter 589, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to prostitution control.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 589, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 589.720, to read as follows:

**589.720. 1. Except as provided in subsection 4 of this section, any home rule city
2 with more than four hundred thousand inhabitants and located in more than one county;
3 any city not within a county; or any city located wholly or partially within a county with
4 a charter form of government and with more than six hundred thousand but fewer than
5 seven hundred thousand inhabitants or wholly or partially within a county with a charter
6 form of government and with more than one million inhabitants which experiences a
7 problem with prostitution may create, maintain, and make public a list of the names of
8 persons who plead guilty to or are found guilty of patronizing prostitution as follows:**

9 **(1) The city may place the name of any person who has pleaded guilty to or been
10 found guilty of patronizing prostitution one time on the list for a maximum of ninety days;**

11 **(2) The city may place the name of any person who has pleaded guilty to or been
12 found guilty of patronizing prostitution a second time on the list for a maximum of one
13 year; and**

14 **(3) The city may place the name of any person who has pleaded guilty to or been
15 found guilty of patronizing prostitution a third or subsequent time on the list for a period
16 of three years.**

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.

17 **2. In addition for any person who has pleaded guilty to or been found guilty of**
18 **patronizing prostitution a second time the city may notify any person living within two**
19 **hundred feet of the residence of the defendant of the person's name and offenses.**

20 **3. In addition for any person who has pleaded guilty to or been found guilty of**
21 **patronizing prostitution a third or subsequent time the city may post the defendant's name**
22 **and offenses in the newspaper of record in the county of the defendant's residence.**

23 **4. If a city chooses to utilize any of the provisions of this section it shall do so for**
24 **all persons who have pleaded guilty to or been found guilty of patronizing prostitution.**
