AN ACT

To amend chapter 9, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to designation of Christmas Day in Missouri.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 9, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 9.012, to read as follows:

9.012. December twenty-fifth of each year shall be known and designated as
2 **"Christmas Day" in Missouri, and shall be set apart as a day in honor of the Christian**
3 **feast commemorating the birth of Jesus Christ.**
