AN ACT

To amend chapter 304, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the use of automated photo red light enforcement systems.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 304, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 304.930, to read as follows:

**304.930. 1. No county, city, town, village, municipality, state agency, or other
2 political subdivision that is authorized to issue a notice of violation for a violation of a state
3 or local traffic law shall employ the use of an automated photo red light enforcement
4 system at any intersection within its jurisdiction, except such system may be used in a
5 school zone, construction zone, or work zone.**

**6 2. As used in this section, the term "automated photo red light enforcement system"
7 means a device, consisting of a camera or cameras and a vehicle sensor or sensors, installed
8 to work in conjunction with a traffic control signal, which is used to produce recorded
9 images of motor vehicles entering an intersection against a red signal indication.**
