AN ACT

To amend chapter 392, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to telecommunications.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 392, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 392.461, to read as follows:

3 **392.461. A telecommunications company shall not be required to comply with rules**
4 **established by the commission which include provisions already mandated by the Federal**
5 **Communications Commission (including but not limited to federal rules regarding**
6 **customer propriety network information and slamming and cramming) and rules relating**
7 **to the installation, provisioning, or termination of retail service. Notwithstanding other**
8 **provisions of this chapter or chapter 386, a telecommunications company shall not be**
9 **required to file any tariffs or schedules of rates, rentals, or charges for service with the**
10 **commission for the offering of residential and business retail services sold to end user**
11 **customers.**
