AN ACT

To amend chapter 589, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to prostitution control.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 589, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 589.720, to read as follows:

589.720. 1. Except as provided in subsection 4 of this section, any urban city which experiences a problem with prostitution may create, maintain, and make public a list of the names of persons who plead guilty to or are found guilty of patronizing prostitution as follows:

(1) The city may place the name of any person who has pleaded guilty to or been found guilty of patronizing prostitution one time on the list for a maximum of ninety days;

(2) The city may place the name of any person who has pleaded guilty to or been found guilty of patronizing prostitution a second time on the list for a maximum of one year; and

(3) The city may place the name of any person who has pleaded guilty to or been found guilty of patronizing prostitution a third or subsequent time on the list for a period of three years.

2. In addition for any person who has pleaded guilty to or been found guilty of patronizing prostitution a second time the city may notify any person living within two hundred feet of the residence of the defendant of the person's name and offenses.

3. In addition for any person who has pleaded guilty to or been found guilty of patronizing prostitution a third or subsequent time the city may post the defendant's name and offenses in the newspaper of record in the county of the defendant's residence.

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in bold-face type in the above bill is proposed language.
