Notice of Proposed Rule Change

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-sixth
2 General Assembly, First Regular Session, that Rule 104 be amended to read as follows:

4 Rule 104. The majority of those present, not under arrest, may make an order for the censure or
5 fine of delinquent members, and prescribe the terms under which they shall be discharged. **Any**
6 **member who removes himself or herself from the state of Missouri during a regular session**
7 **of the House for the purpose of avoiding any official duty or vote shall be subject to a fine**
8 **for each legislative day of his or her delinquency and such fine shall be not less than the**
9 **average legislative daily salary paid to the member. The average legislative daily salary**
10 **shall be calculated by dividing the annual salary of the member by the number of calendar**
11 **days in the year. Any member removing himself or herself in the same manner during a**
12 **special session of the House shall be subject to an equivalent fine by equivalent calculation.**

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of
15 Representatives be instructed to prepare a properly inscribed copy of this resolution.
