AN ACT

To appropriate money for supplemental purposes for the several departments and offices of state government, and for the payment of various claims for refunds, for persons, firms, and corporations, and for other purposes, and to transfer money among certain funds, from the funds designated for the fiscal period ending June 30, 2011.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

There is appropriated out of the State Treasury, chargeable to the fund and for the agency
2 and purpose designated, for the period ending June 30, 2011, as follows:

- 15 Personal Care Option must be allowed to choose, from among all
- 16 the program options, that option which best meets their unmet
- 17 needs as determined by 19 CSR 30 81.030; and also be allowed to
- 18 have their MO HealthNet funds follow them to the extent
- 19 necessary to meet their unmet needs whichever option they choose.
