

HB 96 -- Air and Water Pollution Violations

Sponsor: Flanigan

This bill imposes penalties, including the loss of operating permits, on any recycling company that converts animal parts into petroleum which has violated the air or water pollution requirements of Sections 643.151 or 644.076, RSMo, at least six times during a 12-month period or at least 12 times during a 36-month period.

Any second or subsequent violation of these provisions during a 36-month period will result in a penalty of at least \$10,000, but not more than \$30,000, for each day that the violation continues.
