

HB 162 -- WORKERS' COMPENSATION (Fisher)

COMMITTEE OF ORIGIN: Committee on Workforce Development and  
Workplace Safety

This bill specifies that every employer who is subject to the workers' compensation provisions of Chapter 287, RSMo, must be liable to furnish compensation for the personal injury or death of an employee by occupational disease arising out of and in the course of the employee's employment. An employer or his or her employee will not be liable for any injury or death for which compensation is recoverable under the provisions of Chapter 287.

FISCAL NOTE: No impact on state funds in FY 2012, FY 2013, and FY 2014.
