

HB 184 -- COMPENSATION FOR COMMISSIONERS OF ROAD DISTRICTS

SPONSOR: Dugger

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "do pass by consent" by the Committee on Local Government by a vote of 16 to 0.

This bill authorizes commissioners of road districts organized under Sections 233.170 - 233.315, RSMo, upon majority vote, to provide compensation for their services of up to \$100 per month plus all expenses incurred in transacting business of the district. The compensation of a commissioner cannot change during the time of his or her term of office. Currently, only the payment of expenses is authorized.

FISCAL NOTE: No impact on state funds in FY 2012, FY 2013, and FY 2014.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that many governing boards of other political subdivisions already have the authority to set board member compensation and road district commissions should also have that authority.

Testifying for the bill was Representative Dugger.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
