

HB 216 -- Aluminum Smelting Facility Electric Rates

This bill prohibits the Missouri Public Service Commission from approving any tariff of an electrical corporation that directly or indirectly establishes a single customer class if the customer is an aluminum smelting facility. When setting rates, the commission must allocate to the aluminum smelting facility all costs directly attributable or related to providing electric power and delivery services to the facility and not to any other residential customer or class. Any charges not recovered by an electrical corporation from a facility that are directly attributable to the providing of electric power and delivery services will be declared unjust, unreasonable, unduly discriminatory, and in violation of Section 393.130, RSMo.
