

HB 416 -- Public Library District Sales Tax

Sponsor: Richardson

This bill authorizes a public library district located at least partially in the counties of Butler, Dunklin, New Madrid, Pemiscot, Ripley, Stoddard, or Wayne to impose, upon voter approval, a sales tax of up to one-half of one cent for the operation and maintenance of public libraries within the district. State appropriations to public library districts will not be affected by a voluntary reduction in property tax levies resulting from the enactment of a library district sales tax if the sales tax revenue equals or exceeds the reduction in property tax revenue.
