1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 813, Page 2, Section 67.085, Line 22,
2 by inserting after all of said line the following:

3 “House Committee Substitute for Senate Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for
4 Senate Bill No. 470, Page 2, Section 142.932, Line 29, by inserting after all of said line the
5 following:

6 “260.247. 1. Any city or political subdivision which annexes an area or enters into or
7 expands solid waste collection services into an area where the collection of solid waste is
8 presently being provided by one or more private entities, for commercial or residential services,
9 shall notify the private entity or entities of its intent to provide solid waste collection services in
10 the area by certified mail.

11 _____ 2. A city or political subdivision shall not commence solid waste collection in such area
12 for at least two years from the effective date of the annexation or at least two years from the
13 effective date of the notice that the city or political subdivision intends to enter into the business
14 of solid waste collection or to expand existing solid waste collection services into the area, unless
15 the city or political subdivision contracts with the private entity or entities to continue such
16 services for that period. If for any reason the city or political subdivision does not exercise its
17 option to provide for or contract for the provision of services within an affected area within three
18 years from the effective date of the notice, then the city or political subdivision shall renotify
19 under subsection 1 of this section.

20 3. If the services to be provided under a contract with the city or political subdivision
21 pursuant to subsection 2 of this section are substantially the same as the services rendered in the
22 area prior to the decision of the city to annex the area or to enter into or expand its solid waste

1 collection services into the area, the amount paid by the city shall be at least equal to the amount
2 the private entity or entities would have received for providing such services during that period.

3 4. Any private entity or entities which provide collection service in the area which the city
4 or political subdivision has decided to annex or enter into or expand its solid waste collection
5 services into shall make available upon written request by the city not later than thirty days
6 following such request all information in its possession or control which pertains to its activity in
7 the area necessary for the city to determine the nature and scope of the potential contract.

8 5. If a home rule city with more than fifty-two thousand but fewer than sixty-four
9 thousand inhabitants located in a county with a charter form of government and with more than
10 six hundred thousand but fewer than seven hundred thousand inhabitants intends to expand solid
11 waste collection services into an area where the collection of solid waste is presently being
12 provided by one or more private entities such intent shall be put to a vote of the people in the area
13 where the city intends to expand.

14 6. The provisions of this section shall apply to private entities that service fifty or more
15 residential accounts or any commercial accounts in the area in question.”; and
