HOUSE BILL NO. 1094

AN ACT

To repeal section 205.042, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof two new sections relating to payment systems.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section A. Section 205.042, RSMo, is repealed and two new
2 sections enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as sections 37.007
3 and 205.042, to read as follows:

4 37.007. Within six months of August 28, 2012, the
5 commissioner of the office of administration shall develop and
6 implement a statewide system or contract with any third party to
7 allow all state agencies and departments to accept payments made
8 by a credit card, debit card, or other electronic method
9 designated by the commissioner. State agencies and departments
10 shall not incur any additional fees for utilizing such payment
11 methods.

12 205.042. 1. The trustees, within ten days after their
13 appointment or election, shall qualify by taking the oath of
14 civil officers and organize as a board of health center trustees
15 by the election of one of their number as chairman, one as

1 secretary, one as treasurer, and by the election of such other
2 officers as they may deem necessary, but no bond shall be
3 required of them.

4 2. No trustee shall receive any compensation for his
5 services performed, but he may receive reimbursement for any cash
6 expenditures actually made for personal expenses incurred as such
7 trustee, and an itemized statement of all such expenses and money
8 paid out shall be made under oath by each of such trustees and
9 filed with the secretary and allowed only by the affirmative vote
10 of all of the trustees present at a meeting of the board.

11 3. The board of health center trustees shall make and adopt
12 such bylaws, rules and regulations for its own guidance and for
13 the government of the county health center as may be deemed
14 expedient for the economic and equitable conduct thereof. It
15 shall have the exclusive control of the expenditures of all
16 moneys collected to the credit of the county health center fund,
17 and of the purchase of site or sites, the purchase or
18 construction of any county health center buildings, and of the
19 supervision, care and custody of the grounds, rooms or buildings
20 purchased, constructed, leased or set apart for that purpose.
21 All moneys received for the county health center shall be
22 credited to the county health center and deposited in the
23 depository thereof for the sole use of such county health center
24 in accordance with the provisions of sections 205.010 to 205.150.
25 All funds received by each county health center shall be paid out
26 [only] through an electronic funds transfer system in an amount
27 within that approved by the board of health center trustees or
28 upon warrants ordered drawn by the treasurer of the board of

1 trustees upon properly authenticated vouchers of the board of
2 health center trustees.

3 4. The board of health center trustees may appoint and
4 remove such personnel as may be necessary and fix their
5 compensation; and shall in general carry out the spirit and
6 intent of sections 205.010 to 205.150 pertaining to establishing
7 and maintaining a county health center.

8 5. The board of health center trustees shall hold meetings
9 at least once each month, and shall keep a complete record of all
10 of its proceedings. Three members of the board shall constitute
11 a quorum for the transaction of business.

12 6. One of the trustees shall visit and examine the county
13 health center at least twice each month.

14 7. When the county health center is established, all
15 personnel and all persons approaching or coming within the limits
16 of same, and all furniture and other articles used or brought
17 there shall be subject to such rules and regulations as the board
18 may prescribe.

19 8. The board of health center trustees shall determine
20 annually the rate of the tax levy, except that the rate so
21 determined shall not exceed the maximum rate authorized by the
22 vote of the people of the county.

23 9. The board of health center trustees may enter into
24 contracts and agreements with federal, state, county, school and
25 municipal governments and with private individuals, partnerships,
26 firms, associations and corporations for the furtherance of
27 health activities, except as hereafter prohibited.
