

HB 1076 -- Renewable Energy Pilot Program for State Parks

This bill establishes the Renewable Energy Pilot Program for State Parks which requires the Department of Natural Resources, in consultation with the Missouri Public Service Commission, to develop and implement a pilot program with the goal of achieving 100% energy use from renewable energy resources in a department-selected state park by August 28, 2018. The department must attempt to use as many energy-efficient products as possible within the park.

Beginning August 28, 2012, the department must annually submit a report to the General Assembly documenting progress toward the goal and proposing alternative suggestions for future implementation until the pilot project is complete.
