

HB 1807 -- TROOPER FRED F. GUTHRIE JR. MEMORIAL HIGHWAY

SPONSOR: Marshall

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "do pass by consent" by the Committee on Transportation by a vote of 11 to 0.

This bill designates the portion of Interstate 29 in Platte County from the intersection of State Highway 273/State Highway 371 north to the intersection of State Route U/State Route E as the "Trooper Fred F. Guthrie Jr. Memorial Highway." The costs for the designation are to be paid by private donations.

FISCAL NOTE: No impact on state funds in FY 2013, FY 2014, and FY 2015.

PROPOSERS: Supporters say that Trooper Guthrie was a great trooper, husband, father, and community leader who sacrificed his life trying to save others.

Testifying for the bill were Representative Marshall; State Highway Patrol; and Missouri State Troopers Association.

OPPOSERS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
