

HB 1868 -- CHRISTOPHER S. "KIT" BOND HIGHWAY

SPONSOR: Cauthorn

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "do pass by consent" by the Committee on Transportation by a vote of 11 to 0.

This bill designates the portion of Business Route 54 within the city limits of Mexico in Audrain County as the "Christopher S. 'Kit' Bond Highway." The costs for the designation are to be paid by private donations.

FISCAL NOTE: No impact on state funds in FY 2013, FY 2014, and FY 2015.

PROPOSERS: Supporters say that Kit Bond has been a great champion for Missouri as a three-term United States Senator, two-term Governor, and a State Auditor and has served the people of Missouri with distinction.

Testifying for the bill was Representative Cauthorn.

OPPOSERS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
