

HB 1882 -- Food Stamp Assistance

Sponsor: Brown (116)

This bill requires the income and financial resources of an individual who was determined to be ineligible and remains ineligible for food stamps prior to the federal Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity Act of 1996 due to the individual's immigration status to be considered in determining the eligibility and the value of the allotment of the individual's household.

The income and financial resources of an individual determined to be ineligible for food stamps due to the individual's immigration status must not be considered when determining the eligibility and value of the allotment of the individual's household. The resulting benefit amount for eligible members must be capped at the allotment amount the household would have received if the ineligible household member had been included as listed under the specified categories given to states.
