

HB 1922 -- Missouri Department of Transportation and Highway
Patrol Employees' Retirement System Health Benefits Plan

Sponsor: Molendorp

This bill requires the Highways and Transportation Commission within the Department of Transportation to establish a board of trustees for the general administration of the existing health care plan of the Missouri Department of Transportation and Highway Patrol Employees' Retirement System.

The Superintendent of the State Highway Patrol is added as an advisor to the health care programs sponsored by the department and the patrol. The health care programs sponsored by the department and the patrol will become a part of this plan only upon the request to and the acceptance by the board of trustees of the Highways and Transportation Commission and the Superintendent of the State Highway Patrol and any transfer into this plan must be deemed reviewable by the department or the patrol every three years.
