

HB 2058 -- Special License Plate

This bill allows any woman who currently serves in any branch of the United States Armed Forces or who was honorably discharged from the service to apply for a special license plate bearing the words "Women Veterans" except for a commercial vehicle weighing over 12,000 pounds.

To obtain this plate, a person must make application to the Director of the Department of Revenue and furnish proof of military service. There will be no additional fee to the regular registration fees for the initial set of plates but for each subsequent set of plates there will be a fee equal to the fee charged for personalized license plates which will only have to be paid once. These plates cannot be transferable to any other person except that a registered co-owner of the vehicle must be entitled to operate the vehicle with the plates until they expire in the event of the death of the qualified person.
