

HCS HJR 41 -- GENERAL ASSEMBLY TERM LIMITS

SPONSOR: Dugger (Nasheed)

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "do pass" by the Committee on Elections by a vote of 10 to 0.

Upon voter approval, this proposed constitutional amendment prohibits any member of the General Assembly from serving more than 16 years in any one house nor more than 16 years total in both houses.

FISCAL NOTE: Estimated Net Cost on General Revenue Fund of \$0 or More than \$7,000,000 in FY 2013, \$0 in FY 2014, and \$0 in FY 2015. No impact on Other State Funds in FY 2013, FY 2014, and FY 2015.

PROPOSERS: Supporters say that allowing experienced people to serve additional years in the General Assembly will be very helpful and valuable with the complex and important issues that it considers.

Testifying for the bill were Representative Nasheed; and St. Louis County Municipal League.

OPPOSERS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
